

Working Holiday Slovenia

Complete guide to requirements and application

Universal Requirements

Key rules applying to all nationalities applying for the visa

Proof of Funds

How to demonstrate them?

Through an official bank statement in PDF strictly in your name. Sponsors or joint accounts are not accepted. It must be stamped and translated according to consular requirements.

Can I extend my WHV?

You cannot extend the visa under this category. The maximum stay limit is exactly 12 months. To change your immigration status, you must follow local regulations.

Additional Documents



Medical Exams

Generally, no complex medical certificates are required for your application, unless specifically requested by the consulate.



Criminal Record

You must submit a duly apostilled criminal record certificate and, if required by the consulate, translated.



Language & Translation

Knowing Slovenian is not mandatory to apply. However, all key official documents must be translated into the indicated language.

Health Insurance & Studies

- **Mandatory insurance:** Minimum coverage of €30,000 for your entire stay (including hospitalization and repatriation).
- **Temporary coverage:** It must cover exactly the 12 months of the visa's duration from the moment of entry into the Schengen area.
- **Education:** Studying is allowed as a secondary activity (short language or improvement courses).



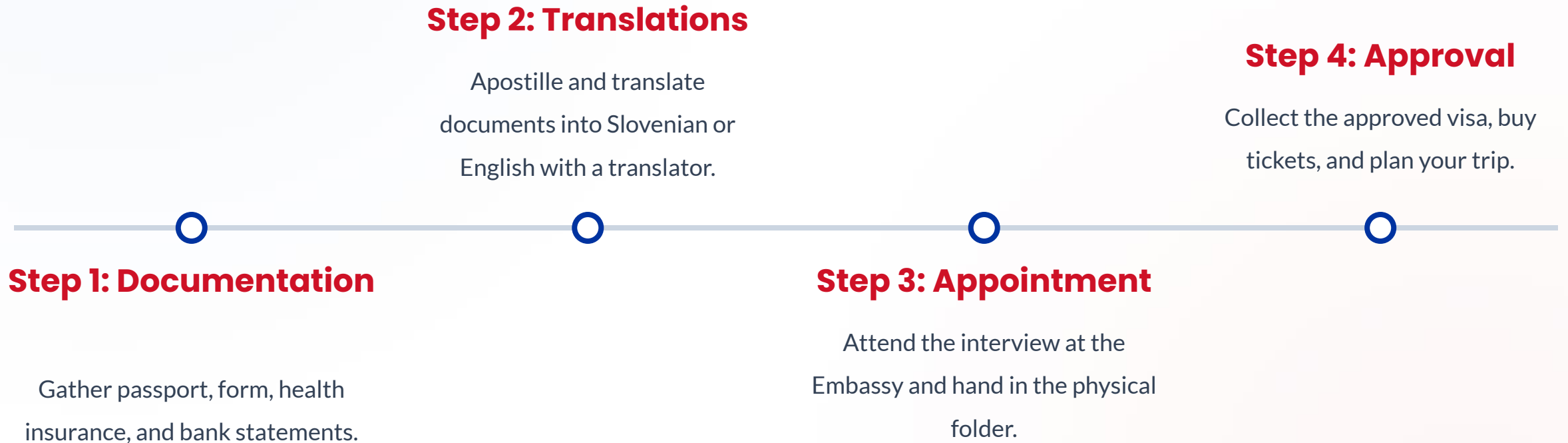

Nationalities Comparison

Nationality	Allowed Age	Available Quotas	Application Type
Argentina	18 to 30 years	200 per year	Consular In-person
Chile	18 to 30 years	200 per year	Consular In-person
New Zealand	18 to 30 years	100 per year	Hybrid / In-person
Australia	18 to 30 years	Unlimited (Agreement)	Hybrid / In-person

Application Process



Types of Application

Consular Process (Latin America)

Applicable for citizens of Argentina and Chile. Requires in-person application at the Embassy (e.g., Buenos Aires). You must submit a printed form, receipts, and all physical documents.

Process for Other Countries

Depending on the bilateral agreement (e.g., New Zealand/Australia), some applicants might have flexibility in presenting or submitting documents. Check your local embassy's specifications.

Official Application Checklist



Official Form: Completed and hand-signed according to Embassy instructions.



Valid Passport: Copy of all pages and a minimum validity of one year and three months upon entry.



Financial Solvency: Bank statement proving sufficient funds (approx. €2,500 to €3,000).



Flight Ticket: Return ticket or proof of extra funds to purchase one.



Health Insurance: Annual policy translated and with a medical repatriation clause.

Key Visa Facts

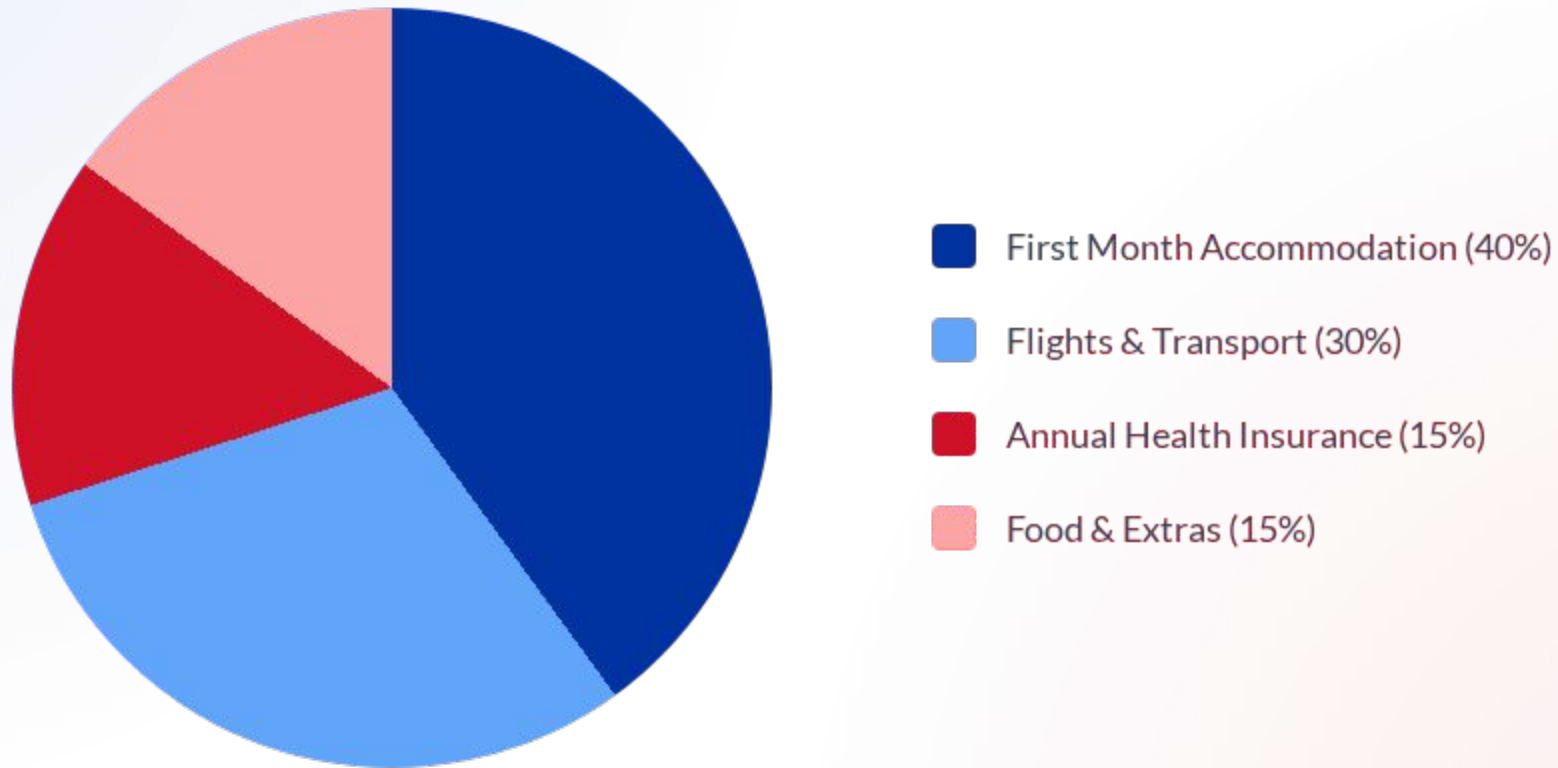
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Months (Maximum Duration)

The Age Limit

The maximum age for most Spanish-speaking countries (including Argentina and Chile) is **30 years**. You must apply for the visa before turning 31.

Note: The proof of funds required by the consulate guarantees your initial survival, but planning this budget will give you greater peace of mind while looking for a job in Slovenia.
